Located in Isle La Motte, a pristine location in Grand Isle County

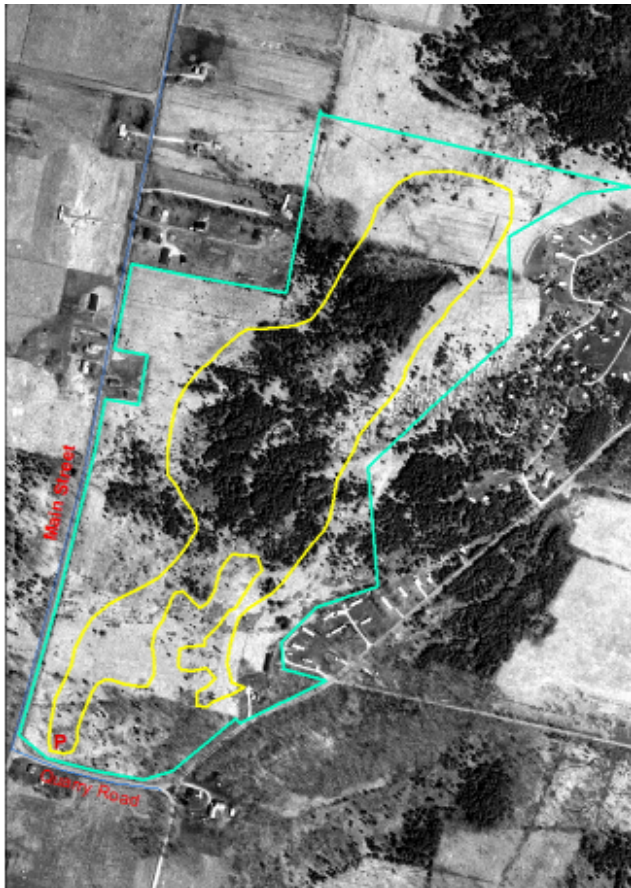
Inspiring Learning Environment

Directions

From the South: Get off I-89 at exit 17 and onto Route 2W. Just after crossing the bridge into Alburgh, turn left onto Route 129. Continue for just over 7 miles, Route 129 will turn into Main Street, and then turn left onto Quarry Road, which is just after the Historical Society. Parking lot is ¼ of a mile down the road on the left near an old farmhouse.
