

Removing Invasive Species: Honeysuckle

Lonicera sp.



Identifying Honeysuckle: Oval, opposite leaves with white irregular flowers (top left) and bright red berries (top right). It is a shrub (bottom).



To completely remove, use a weed wrench to pull out the entire root system.



Replace with a native evergreen shrub called Northern Bayberry (*Morella pensylvanica*). It has a long life-span and blooms in the late spring, getting blue berries in the summer and fall.
