From Route 7 turn East onto Marsett Road – almost across from the Shelburne Museum. Follow as it becomes Falls Road until the bridge crossing the La Platte River Waterfalls. Immediately after the bridge, turn right onto Thomas Road. Turn right down the first marked driveway to 480 Thomas Road.
